



## **MONEYGRAM'S GLOBAL GIVING PROGRAM**

### ***Focus Area Objectives***

MoneyGram supports organizations that strengthen the global communities we serve. Each year MoneyGram contributes to local, national and international programs that will directly benefit our consumers.

We understand the success of our company is directly related to being a good corporate citizen. Our goal is to use our resources and skills in the following three focus areas when determining whether or not a request fits our funding criteria:

- 1. Basic Needs and Affordable Housing:** In addition to our five-year, million dollar commitment to Habitat for Humanity, MoneyGram supports programs or services that provide housing, shelter, food or other basic needs service to individuals and families in our global community. MoneyGram also supports community development programs that address low-to-moderate income populations and disadvantaged or underrepresented groups. Programs in the following areas are preferred:
  - a. Homeless shelters
  - b. Food pantries and/or food shelves
  - c. Services for children
  - d. Services for the elderly
  - e. Neighborhood and after-school programs
  - f. Programs that increase affordable home ownership

**2. Education:** MoneyGram believes that we have a responsibility to support programs and services which inspire adults and children to have a more promising future. Programs in the following areas are preferred:

- a. Community education programs
- b. Programs teaching basic parenting skills
- c. Programs teaching literacy and language skills

**3. Global Healthcare and Disaster Relief:** A good quality of life starts with good health. MoneyGram supports programs that address preventative healthcare throughout the world, as well as organizations providing support to those suffering from disasters, disease and other health-related issues. Programs in the following areas are preferred:

- a. Programs supporting immunization and disease prevention in children throughout the world
- b. Programs supporting disease and famine prevention on a global scale
- c. Programs providing disaster relief
- d. Programs supporting prenatal and other preventative healthcare

Each focus area is defined by the MoneyGram Global Giving Board and is reviewed on an annual basis.

Our contributions are limited to 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations and all applicants must complete our application process. Applications can be found on our website or by calling MoneyGram at 952-591-3839.

As a general rule, we do not offer corporate contributions for:

- Individuals
- Religious organizations not related to social services
- Political, labor or veterans organizations
- Private foundations or public broadcasting companies

- Fraternal organizations
- Environmental or animal rights organizations
- Arts, recreation or athletic events or programs

If it is necessary to decline support of a worthwhile organization or program, the decision is not reflective of the value of the organization or program, but rather on the need to be selective due to limited resources.
